

Youngblood Disposal Front Load Driver Job Type:

Full-time, Monday thru Friday (scheduled Saturdays will be required for some major account service as well as holiday weeks)

Drive assigned company truck to various commercial locations and mechanically lifting and dumping refuse or recycling containers into truck body.

Please note: Drivers are required to safely climb in & out of truck multiple times throughout the work day, in order to open and close gates from customer container corrals.

Qualifications Requirements

- Driver must be at least 21 years of age.
- Legally eligible to work in the United States.
- Holds Valid Class A or B Commercial Driver License (CDL) and DOT mandated Medical Card.
- Must have at least two (2) years of CDL Driving Experience.
- Must meet all qualifications as defined under DOT regulation 49 CFR 383.51.
- Possess and maintain a clean safety and driving record.
- Able to use interpersonal skills relating to good customer service.
- Pass a pre-employment, DOT physical, Agility Performance Exam & Drug Test.
- Knowledge of the Rochester and surrounding areas a plus.
- Ensure compliance with company policies and safety.
- Communicate with Supervisor(s) and/or dispatchers throughout the day.

Role and Responsibilities

- Daily punctuality for your work shift and attendance is required and expected.
- Maintain a positive and professional attitude at all times.
- Perform both a Pre-Trip & Post Trip Vehicle Condition Reports (VCR) per DOT Regulations.
- Drive an automatic transmission heavy duty diesel truck to perform collection service of various size front load dumpsters at various commercial locations by yourself.
- Will be getting in and out of truck multiple times throughout the day to open and close gates and fences of container enclosures.
- Operate truck in a safe manner in compliance with all local, state and company regulations.
- Will need to back up safely at every location you will be servicing, approximately 75 to 100 times per day.
- Operates joystick hand controls to lift & letdown various sized containers, operate truck compactor and dispose of collected refuse and recycling to designated disposal facilities.
- Courteous and Professional interaction with customers, fellow workers, dispatchers and supervisors.
- Read computerized route sheets to determine daily pickups as identified on the route sheet assigned by your Supervisor.
- Follow and maintain all requirements from the company maintenance department.
- Maintain and keep your assigned truck clean.
- Complete all Company assigned paperwork.
- Follows all Safety Policies and Procedures. Must attend mandatory monthly safety meetings.
- Must have the ability to work in all types of weather conditions.
- Be able to work 45-55 hours a week as assigned by your Supervisor.
- Start time is around 2:30 am but may vary depending on company discretion.
