

Youngblood Disposal Residential Collection Driver Job Type:

Full-time, Monday thru Friday (some Saturdays will be required for major holiday weeks)

Drive an assigned rear load company truck, along with a helper to an established residential customer route each day to service their solid waste and recyclable needs.

Please note: Drivers are required to safely climb in & out of truck multiple times throughout the work day to service residential and commercial customers. Additionally, you will be required to assist your helper in lifting oversized items into the packer truck hopper.

Qualifications Requirements

- Driver must be at least 21 years of age.
- Legally eligible to work in the United States.
- Holds Valid Class A or B Commercial Driver License (CDL) and DOT mandated Medical Card.
- Must meet all qualifications as defined under DOT regulation 49 CFR 383.51.
- Possess and maintain a clean safety and driving record.
- Able to use interpersonal skills relating to good customer service.
- Pass a pre-employment, DOT physical, Agility Performance Exam & Drug Test.
- Knowledge of the Rochester and surrounding areas a plus.
- Ensure compliance with company policies and safety.
- Communicate with Supervisor(s) and/or dispatchers throughout the day.

Role and Responsibilities

- Daily punctuality for your work shift and attendance is required and expected.
- Maintain a positive and professional attitude at all times.
- Will need to go through company safety and route orientation training.
- Perform both a Pre-Trip & Post Trip Vehicle Condition Reports (VCR) per DOT Regulations.
- Drive an automatic transmission heavy duty diesel truck to perform collection service at Residential and Commercial Locations.
- Operate truck in a safe manner in compliance with all local, state and company regulations.
- Operates hydraulic hand controls to lift & let down various sized toter containers, operate compactor and dispose of collected refuse and recycling to designated disposal facilities.
- On occasion, service rear load dumpsters using a winch cable, dumping in the back of a refuse packer.
- Work consists of physical lifting of various items discarded by residential customers during the work day.
- Driver will be getting in and out of assigned vehicle a majority of his work day. This may vary depending on daily volume of material generated by customers.
- Courteous and Professional interaction with customers, fellow workers, dispatchers and supervisors.
- Read computerized route sheets to determine daily pickups as identified on the route sheet assigned by your Supervisor.
- Follow and maintain all requirements from the company maintenance department.
- Maintain and keep your assigned truck clean.
- Complete all Company assigned paperwork.
- Follows all Safety Policies and Procedures. Must attend mandatory monthly safety meetings
- Perform other job- related duties as assigned.
- Must have the ability to work in all types of weather conditions.
- Be able to work 40-50 hours a week. Work daily shifts as assigned by your Supervisor.
- Start times are around 5:30 am but may vary depending on company scheduling.

The level of physical effort may vary in some cases to be greater or lesser than documented here.
