

Youngblood Disposal Roll Off Driver Job Type:

Full-time, Monday thru Friday (Saturdays and/or Sundays may be required for major account service)

Drive assigned company truck to various commercial locations using mechanically operated cable/hook system to place or pickup various sized roll off containers at residential or commercial locations.

Please note: Drivers are required to safely climb in and out of truck multiple times throughout the work day to cover or remove tarp from roll off box. Place protective wood under roll off box. Hook and unhook cable from roll off box.

Qualifications Requirements

- Legally eligible to work in the United States.
- Holds Valid Class A or B Commercial Driver License (CDL) and DOT mandated Medical Card.
- Must have at least two (2) years of CDL Driving Experience.
- Must meet all qualifications as defined under DOT regulation 49 CFR 383.51.
- Possess and maintain a clean safety and driving record.
- Able to use interpersonal skills relating to good customer service.
- Pass a pre-employment, DOT physical, Agility Performance Exam & Drug Test.
- Knowledge of the Rochester and surrounding areas is a plus.
- Ensure compliance with company policies and safety.
- Communicate with Supervisor(s) and/or dispatchers throughout the day.
- Some knowledge with Smartphone software is a plus.

Role and Responsibilities

- Daily punctuality for your work shift and attendance is required and expected.
- Maintain a positive and professional attitude at all times.
- Perform both a Pre-Trip & Post Trip Vehicle Condition Reports (VCR) per DOT Regulations.
- Drive a standard transmission heavy duty diesel truck to perform deliveries and collection service of various size roll off containers at Residential and Commercial Locations.
- Operate truck in a safe manner in compliance with all local, state and company regulations.
- Operates hydraulic hand controls to lift & place various sized containers at customer locations, and dispose of collected refuse and recycling to designated disposal facilities.
- Cover and tarp containers before transporting to the disposal or recycling facility.
- Courteous and Professional interaction with customers, fellow workers, dispatchers and supervisors..
- Read job tickets and/or maps, follow assignments from the dispatcher or supervisor to service customers.
- Follow and maintain all requirements from the company maintenance department.
- Maintain and keep your assigned truck clean.
- Complete all Company assigned paperwork.
- Follows all Safety Policies and Procedures. Must attend mandatory monthly safety meetings.
- Perform other job- related duties as assigned.
- Must have the ability to work in all types of weather conditions.
- Work daily shifts as assigned by your Supervisor. Shift times may vary depending on customer needs.
- Start times are around 5:30 am but may vary, day to day depending on customer needs.
